To Our Residents and Family Members:

As part of our ongoing infection control efforts, **Warsaw Nursing and Rehab Center** continues to test all residents and employees for COVID-19 regularly per the direction of the local health department and CMS/CDC guidance, to prevent COVID-19 from entering and spreading in our building. On July 14, 2020, we completed another round of testing on all residents and employees through our partnership with Goshen Medical. **Warsaw Nursing and Rehab Center** will provide additional updates when the testing results are available.

The safety and wellbeing of our residents continues to be our top priority. We are doing everything we can to prevent COVID-19 from entering **Warsaw Nursing and Rehab Center**, including staying in very close communication with local and state health officials to ensure we are taking all the appropriate steps during this pandemic.

We are taking steps based on guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to reduce the spread and impact of COVID-19, such as:

- Enhanced infection control precautions
- Screening residents, staff, and essential visitors for expanded list of symptoms
- Restricting visitation and entry of people to the building
- Proactively testing staff and residents for COVID-19 based on current protocols
- Postponing communal activities
- Increasing PPE par levels
- And CDC/CMS recommendations

We also understand that connecting with family members is incredibly important to our residents. Additionally, we encourage family members to connect with their loved ones through video chat, calling or facetime. We can also arrange for window visits.
