To Our Residents and Family Members:

In our ongoing communication with you during the COVID-19 pandemic, **Warsaw Nursing and Rehab** continues to issue communication regarding the status of our residents and employees. **Warsaw Nursing and Rehab** recently participated in three COVID-19 vaccination clinics and are seeing significant declines in positivity rates in our residents and employees because of our high participation. We are pleased to share that **71%** of our employees and **92%** of our residents have been vaccinated. Duplin County's positivity rate continues to decline and currently sets at 3.60%, which is roughly a 2% decrease from last week, per the issuing of CMS County positivity rates. **Warsaw Nursing and Rehab** will continue testing for COVID-19 once per week as recommended by CMS, until the County positivity rate declines further. Additionally, we are in the planning stages of safely reopening for visitation and will share additional communication once those plans are finalized.

The safety and wellbeing of our residents continues to be our top priority. We are doing everything we can to prevent the spread of COVID-19 within **Warsaw Nursing and Rehab Center**, including staying in very close communication with local and state health officials to ensure we are taking all the appropriate steps under current circumstances. We are taking steps based on guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to reduce the spread and impact of COVID-19, such as:

- Enhanced infection control precautions
- Screening residents, staff, and essential visitors for expanded list of symptoms
- Restricting visitation and entry of people to the building
- Proactively testing staff and residents for COVID-19 based on current protocols
- Postponing communal activities
- Increasing PPE par levels
- And CDC/CMS recommendations

We also understand that connecting with family members is incredibly important to our residents. Additionally, we encourage family members to connect with their loved ones through video chat, calling or facetime. We can also arrange for window visits.
